The Individual

I put in my dimes, quarters, loonies – maybe \$5 a month, or even \$10 or \$20, but how will that small amount help reach others for Christ? I offer my prayers with my mites. Please, Lord, use my small offering to bring the Good News to someone who has never heard it. I have personal devotions and study the Bible but I am only one. How can God use me?

- Each woman of Lutheran Church Canada (LCC) is included here and able to participate in LWML – Canada Inc. activities including Society meetings, Zone Rallies, District events such as Prayer Retreats and National Conventions.
- There are approximately 1500 individual members in LWML Canada Inc.

Here in my own Church, I join with a few more individuals in a Society. Together we work in our congregation and community. Here we use everyone's talents and gifts to help each other serve the Lord. Here we join our sisters for Bible study, prayer and fellowship. We grow spiritually and personally. Each month we collect all the mite boxes and envelopes. Each Society treasurer sends the mites from its members to LWML Canada Inc. Financial Secretary. Now we have more resources to work for the Lord – but we are still small. How can we be much help at all?

- There are 7 individual members in Zion Prince George's Society. We meet on the 2nd Thursday of the month. We study God's Word, enjoy fellowship, give to the Mite program and receive offerings to support Zion Prince George's events and Missions which are voted on in January of each year.
- We thank all the individuals that also support our Society by attending and helping with our events, giving to the Mite Program and donate to the Society missions.
- Every LCC woman is considered to be a member, but without attending the meetings you miss the benefit of Women's Bible Study and Fellowship.
- There are 4 Societies in the Cariboo Zone (not every LCC Congregation has an LWML-C Society)
- There are 139 Societies in LWML Canada Inc.

The Zone



Each Society is part of a Zone with several other Societies in their area. Now we are growing! We are part of a growing circle of Christian sisters. We meet new friends at retreats or renewals. At these events we have many opportunities for fellowship, Bible study and prayer and for using our God-given talent and time to serve God and serve others. Offerings and mites are gathered to serve a broader community. See how our mites are growing!

- The Prince George Society is part of the Cariboo Zone.
- The Cariboo Zone is one of 10 Zones in the Alberta-British Columbia (A-BC) District
- There is a minimum of 2 Zone events per year in the Spring and the Fall. Each event is hosted by a different Society on a rotating basis. The host society chooses the program and activities for the day.
- There are 31 Zones in Canada

The District



Every Zone is part of a District. Districts offer Retreats, Workshops and other Events to encourage the participants in their Christian Faith and Service. At a District Events, offerings are given by the participants and forwarded to the LWML Canada Financial Secretary to support the Mite Program of LWML Canada Inc. How our mites are growing! - There are 4 Districts in Canada; A-BC, Central, Laurentian and Ontario
